Catering Tutor

The post holder will be required to deliver high quality catering tuition, helping students achieve accredited qualifications whilst preparing meals for staff and students at the college sites.

The key duties in this role will include:

- To plan and deliver catering sessions to a small group of students according to their individual learning needs and requirements whilst preparing food for staff and students at the college sites (up to 75 people).
- To embed communication, word and number into all catering sessions with students.
- To be a part of ongoing assessment of students learning needs and to make reasonable adjustments as required minimising barriers to learning and achievement.
- To deliver BTECs in catering and to set sessional targets for the student and to complete progress and achievement paperwork, end of term reports etc
