Set within 58 acres of idyllic parkland, nestled on the slopes of the Clent Hills, we are an independent residential special school and charity who support young people, aged 6 – 19 years, with complex learning needs, including Autism and PDA.

As a CSW at Sunfield, you will work closely with a young person and their family to help them to feel safe, respected, confident and capable of achieving their best, and their family to feel understood, informed, supported and reassured.

We are now recruiting to a number of vacancies both full and part-time. Staff need to be fully flexible and work over a 7 day working week (including weekends and Bank Holidays). All posts within Sunfield are subject to a 6 month probation period and the full-time hours for care staff are 40 per week to be worked in accordance with a rota.

Whether you have care experience and are looking for an organisation that can help you achieve your goals, or you are looking for a career change, we will equip you with everything you need in order to fulfil your desire to help transform a young person's life. This role is the perfect starting point for anyone wanting a career in Care, Education or Psychology as opportunities crossing these areas are available. Sunfield's on-site resources include specialist equipment, a sensory room, a state-of-the-art sensory integration suite and family accommodation, along with resident carers, teachers, psychologists, therapists and healthcare professionals.

A fully-funded QCF Level 3 qualification in Residential Childcare is available. You will be fully trained in the following; CALM, Behaviour Watch, Safeguarding, Health & Safety training alongside Mental Health, Child Development & attachment and Emotional Resilience to name a few.
