Brantwood Specialist School is going through a period of change and expansion and therefore we are looking for teachers in different subject areas to enhance the curriculum in line with Ruskin Mill Trust's methods of practical skills therapeutic education and working in line with Steiner's principles as well work towards student achievement of nationally recognised qualifications such as GCSEs, NOCNs and BTECs within the Ofsted and legislative frameworks.

Brantwood Specialist School and Ruskin Mill Trust offers an innovative waking day curriculum being inspired by the Steiner Waldorf Curriculum and the National to children between 7 and 19 years of age with SEN, autism and complex behavioural or mental health difficulties.

This role requires the integration of the National Curriculum and national qualifications with the Steiner Waldorf Curriculum and to support our teachers achieve this we require all teachers appointed to attend the Ruskin Mill Trust Teacher Development Programme. This course requires attendance at training on several weekends and during traditional school holiday periods.

This will be achieved through trainings, research and working with colleagues within the School and the wider Trust. You must have aspirations to continually personally and professionally develop and to work with the Head Teacher to develop the school in this period of change and expansion and to improve performance with the aim of achieving an Outstanding Ofsted Inspection whilst working with the vision, values and method of the Trust.


