## INCLUSIVE CURRICULUM

Our educational method is Practical Skills Therapeutic Education (PSTE), used at every Ruskin Mill Trust site. This internationally renowned and researched method has a positive impact on young peoples physical development as well as their mental wellbeing. Furthermore it enables them to develop skills across a wide range of areas.

Engagement in PSTE helps students to overcome previous barriers to learning, become skilled through doing purposeful activities and contribute to the community.

## THERAPEUTIC EDUCATION

Therapies are delivered as an integral part of the curriculum at Clervaux and include individual therapies based on the students' needs and Education Health & Care Plan requirements.

The varied range of therapies we use compliment learning and help to break down emotional barriers to educational environments and learning.

## SUPPORTED TRANSITIONS

We appoint key members of staff to work with our pupils and their parents /carers to prepare meaningful targets in preparation for the next stage of their personal journey.

Whether our young people are moving on to a college within Ruskin Mill Trust, local further education, or a work placement, our staff are on hand to support and guide throughout the transition period.
