Occupational Therapist (Self-Employed)

We are a specialist college working with young people between 16 and 25 years old; many of whom have diagnoses of autism, ADHD, dyspraxia and sensory integration difficulties.

The students at Ruskin Mill College benefit from an extensive range of nutritional, therapeutic and medical support within the College. Each core element of the educational cycle is designed to establish active and positive relationships with nature, people and the community through a holistic approach to human development and supports three key stages: overcoming barriers to learning, becoming skilled, and being ready to engage and give back to the community

We are looking for a suitably qualified, BAOT registered, Occupational Therapist to provide assessment, training and advice to staff and other interested parties, such as families. The candidate must be also prepared to work directly with the young people in our care.

The position will be on an independent (self-employed) basis. Hours can be to suit and will be term time, (36 weeks) per year. We are currently anticipating the work to be one day a week; however this might be subject to change.
