The post holder will work closely with students across all areas of the provision, including residential and off-site work and will lead an internal safeguarding team to ensure robust management within all areas of safeguarding practice as well as ensuring that all staff are trained and embed the learning from their training into their daily practice. As the Safeguarding Manager you will also liaise with external stakeholders, debrief staff, deliver training programmes, attend regular meetings, disseminate information and provide updates and plan future training requirements. The post holder also needs to work closely with the Senior Management Team through regular meetings and report back to senior members of the Trust.

You will also be expected to attend training sessions as required by the Trust, which may be outside of your usual working hours as the Trust is committed to staff training and development.
