**Waking Nights Residential Support Worker**

**40 hours per week, 52 weeks per year**

**Salary Range £19,407.36 - £20,453.79 per annum (this includes market supplement)  
starting salary will be dependent on qualifications and experience**

You will be part of a team of Residential Support Workers who support a number of residents with learning difficulties in a home life setting in the centre of Sheffield. This role may be required to provide personal care and work alongside young people with challenging behaviours. You will have responsibility for promoting and ensuring the safety, care, well-being, learning and development of the residents, to enable their growth in confidence and social and practical skills. You will be working on a shift basis working evenings and weekends.

The key duties of this role will include:

- The supervision and support of service users in their residential settings with a range of domestic activities such as cooking, shopping, cleaning and laundry.
- The supervision of the service users at night, including behaviour management, medication handling and carrying out household tasks when residents are sleeping.
- Completion of relevant paperwork is required.

The requirements of this role are:

- Ideally you will be an experienced support worker who has worked in a residential setting and worked with young people with challenging behaviours.
- You may be required to provide personal care to some of our service users and as such it would be beneficial for you to have experience of this as well as medication handling experience.
- You will have excellent communication skills, as well as experience of report writing and record keeping. You will also be expected to attend training sessions as required.
