The Head of Care - Adults will run a portfolio of residential care homes for adults and work collegiately with the children's provision as required. The post-holder will plan, organise, and manage human and physical resources to ensure business growth, financial security, and effective resources management whilst maintaining the reputation for good quality, holistic services across all aspects of the Trust's work. They will be the registered manager for the homes and expected to join on an on-call duty rota.

As the adult residential provision is part of the collaborative provision of Ruskin Mill Trust, the post holder will be expected to embrace, articulate and work with the Ruskin Mill Trust's objectives, vision, values and purpose and method. They will ensure that each of the Homes meets the required standard and expectations regulated by CQC and the Health Social Care Act 2008 (Regulated Activities) Regulations 2014. Whilst also promoting and safeguarding the welfare of adults within our care.

To support this the Trust provides extensive training opportunities and if you have not already achieved your Level 5 qualification in leadership in care then we will look at how we can support you to achieve this.

The post holder may be required to carry out their duties at all premises, some of which are located a distance from the main site and at such other places as may reasonably be required. There may be opportunities for overtime as well covering shifts in the home but these are remunerated at the same rate as a Support Worker.
