Applications are invited for the following post that will be based at the new Clervaux Garden School within the Ruskin Mill Trust.

Steiner Teacher

We have an exciting new opportunity at Clervaux Garden School. The School provides a child-centred curriculum, adapted to each child's developmental and learning needs, and the opportunity to discover each child's path to lifelong learning, offering a variety of educational programs designed to meet the needs of students with developmental delays, social and sensory sensitivities, and learning challenges.

The curriculum is based around our 9-term academic year, each term reflecting a key theme and festival. The terms are 4 or 5 weeks long, followed by a short break, which allow teachers and students to focus on short term, achievable goals and regular opportunities for celebration. Academic sessions in the morning will reflect this project theme, and this will be complemented in the land and craft curriculum in the afternoon. Literacy, Numeracy, PSHE and Fundamental British Values are embedded in all lessons, as are the development of cultural capital, communication and interaction, cognitive and learning skills, therapeutic methods to meet social, emotional and mental health needs and sensory and/or physical needs.

This curriculum is derived from an approach which braids together the insights of Rudolf Steiner with the National Curriculum and Practical Skills Therapeutic Education method of the Ruskin Mill Trust. We are now looking for an exceptional individual who has already qualified as a Steiner Teacher to help embed and role model Steiner's educational principles in the work that we do as well as teach our students.

We can only consider applicants who have already completed their Steiner teaching qualification. Whether this is a UK based programme such as WESTT or a European qualification. In addition we are looking to create a new approach to Steiner influenced Schools so the successful applicant must be willing to teach aspects of the National Curriculum and to provide education that differs from the standard Steiner approach, including the main lesson.
