This is a diverse and fulfilling role involving community engagement through promoting awareness of biodynamic farming methods, selling produce and supporting learners with special educational needs to learn about horticulture and gain work experience.

The successful applicant must be;

- Willing to engage in physically demanding tasks.
- Willing to work outside for the duration of their day in all seasons.
- Be able to work independently and on a flexible shift pattern, dependent on the needs of the land.
- Receptive to biodynamic agriculture principles and methodology. A requirement of the role is to join and complete the Ruskin Mill Land Trust's Biodynamic Training Programme.
