Fixed Term – Bakery Tutor

5 days - 52 Weeks, Grade MS1 to MS4

This role is fixed term contract for one year. The payable salary is from £22,619.83 - £33,437.92 based on qualifications and experience.

The post holder will be required to deliver high quality bakery tuition, helping students achieve accredited qualifications. The successful candidate will have appropriate qualifications, experience and a strong passion for baking organic, artisan bread and baked products. Ruskin Mill Trust has a nutrition policy, which focuses on biodynamic and organic food so we are keen to see applicants who share our passion for nutrition and is familiar with baking using seasonal produce where possible.

The key duties in this role will include:

To plan and deliver bakery sessions to a small group of students according to their individual learning needs and requirements.

To embed communication, word and number skills into all bakery sessions with students.

To be a part of ongoing assessment of students learning needs and to make reasonable adjustments as required minimising barriers to learning and achievement.

The full expectations of a tutor can be found within the job description. We are looking for someone who has already achieved their teaching qualification, is skilled within the craft and has experience of working with young people who have special educational needs. However, we appreciate that there may be excellent candidates for the role who do not yet have experience in all three areas so we are open to applications with experience in one or more of these disciplines but are willing to commit to further professional development.
