Main Duties to include:

- To delivered Speech and Language Therapy predominantly in the workshops across the college; including drama.
- Will need to work on strategies with Tutors rather than 1 to 1 sessions;
- The ability to work with young people with autistic spectrum disorders, learning disabilities and difficulties associated with developmental delay;
- To assess the needs of assessment students prior to them starting at college;
- To provide evidence from assessment for educational tribunals;
- To plan and deliver the therapeutic speech and language needs of individual students with a diverse range of needs;
- The ability to articulate and communicate assessment findings to a diverse range of College staff which may include delivering staff training;
- To work in collaboration with the therapy team and tutors within the College;
- To work towards student outcomes as detailed in the EHCP.

- A BSc in Clinical Communication Studies or equivalent;
- A member of the Health Professional Council;
- A member of the Royal College of Speech and Language;
- Experience of working with learners with learning difficulties and/ or learning disabilities;
