This position will be based within Fusion Café which teaches Catering and Hospitality skills to Freeman College's students while operating as a successful **SOCIAL ENTERPRISE** café for the general public. Fusion Café serves wonderful fresh high quality food mainly focusing on vegetarian and vegan foods from local suppliers including our own Freeman College Bio-Dynamic Garden based in Stannington. The Café is a source of work experience for the College's students, enabling them to work with the community and develop catering and hospitality skills for their future.

The key duties in this role will include:

- To plan and deliver catering sessions to a small group of students according to their individual learning needs and requirements.
- To embed communication, word and number into all catering sessions with students.
- Working in Fusion Café to prepare food to a high standard, using ingredients and methods in line with the Trust's Food and Nutrition Policy.
- Cooking food for the café, college students, staff and outside events using fresh ingredients which are organic, bio-dynamic and locally sourced where possible.
- Adherence to food hygiene and health and safety regulations.
- To be a part of ongoing assessment of students learning needs and to make reasonable adjustments as required minimising barriers to learning and achievement.
- To deliver BTECs in catering and to set sessional targets for the student and to complete progress and achievement paperwork, end of term reports etc

To undertake this position successfully you will have:

- Experience of catering and teaching/training catering
 - Ability to manage the demands of a café service balanced with the needs of the students
 - A teaching qualification or working towards a relevant teaching qualification.
 - Knowledge of specialist education
 - Experience of working with learners with learning difficulties and/ or learning disabilities
 - Excellent communication and organisational skills
